Health Protection Agency Bill

On 3 December 2003, following a plenary debate on the Queen's Speech to Parliament, the National Assembly remitted the Health Protection Agency Bill to the Health and Social Services Committee for scrutiny.

The Committee considered the Bill, in accordance with its agreed protocol for scrutinising legislation, at its meeting on 5 May 2004. At the time of the Committee's consideration the Bill was awaiting its third reading in the House of Lords.

No amendments had been proposed by Members and the Committee was content with the provisions of the Bill as they impact on Wales.
