


REPORT BY THE ENVIRONMENT, PLANNING AND COUNTRYSIDE COMMITTEE

Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Bill

The Committee considered the Bill at its 12 January 2005 meeting. The Bill had been commended to the Committee following the plenary debate on the Queen's Speech¹.

The Committee decided against considering the Bill as it felt that it was too late in its parliamentary process to influence its content. It however noted that the Local Government and Public Service Committee would need to monitor the effect of the Bill on local authorities' resources following its coming into force.

The Committee will consider implementation of the provisions of the Bill once it has received Royal Assent.
