Report By The Health And Social Services Committee

The Children And Adoption Bill

The Committee considered the above Bill at its meeting on 3 November 2005. The Bill had been remitted to the Committee and to the Social Justice and Regeneration Committee, by the Assembly in plenary on 21 June. It was considered in accordance with the protocol for dealing with primary legislation agreed by the Committee on 11 June 2003, whereby Members notify in advance any queries or amendments they wish to propose to the Bill.

Plaid Cymru proposed that a number of amendments that had been sponsored by a number of interested parties, including NSPCC and Barnardo's, should be considered by the Committee.

The amendments related to Part 1 of the Bill, which was outside the remit of the Health and Social Services Committee. The amendments were therefore ruled out of order.

No other amendments or queries had been submitted.
