I write with reference to "The Communities and Culture Inquiry into the funding of Voluntary Sector Organisations in Wales"

We are a National Charitable organisation with an office based in Wales, which has been historically funded by 'The big lottery'

In 2003 we attempted to recruit two field officers, one for the North of Wales, and one for the South.

We were advised at the time that Section 64 would assist us in our Developmental Role within Wales, however we have not been able to access this stream of funding as policy appeared to change regarding the criteria

Originally Section 64 was deemed as a workable proposal by civil servants but then the process to obtain it became somewhat cloudy
