### The Case for Denbighshire County Council

104. Martyn Jones MP was unable to attend the inquiry and submitted written evidence (Doc 66). He was opposed to the proposal mainly on the grounds of noise, television interference, safety and the effect on birds. From Mr Mainwaring's written submissions (Doc 65) I take the view that he supports wind turbines mainly from the point of view of providing additional financial support to upland farmers.
105. There is extensive correspondence from those opposed to the proposal (Doc 67), and a smaller yet still significant number of letters from supporters (Doc 68). The objections generally cover the range of points covered by other witnesses and are similar to those analysed at length in the Planning Officers report (Doc 3 P24-28). The replies from consultees (Doc 69) generally have no comments and do not raise points which are not covered by the section on conditions.
