**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend the National Health Service (Charges to Overseas Visitors) Regulations 1989 (SI 1989/306) (“the 1989 Regulations”). The Regulations remove the Isle of Man from the list of countries or territories in respect of which the United Kingdom Government has entered into a reciprocal agreement in Schedule 2 to the 1989 Regulations.

The Welsh Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 124 of the National Health Service (Wales) Act 2006(1).

**Title, application, commencement and interpretation**

1.—(1) These Regulations are called the National Health Service (Charges to Overseas Visitors) (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2010 and come into force on 1 April 2010.

(2) These Regulations apply in relation to Wales.

(3) In these Regulations, “the principal Regulations” (“y *prif Reoliadau*”) means the National Health Service (Charges to Overseas Visitors) Regulations 1989(2).

**Amendment to the principal Regulations**

2. In Schedule 2 to the principal Regulations delete the words—

“Isle of Man”.
